Fashioned after the factory outlets for branded goods in Britain and the United States, the Nilai 3 wholesale centre in Nilai, Negri Sembilan, has all kinds of everything for the whole family.

F you haven't been to Nilai 3 wholesale centre in Nilai, Negri Sembilan, you don't know what you're missing.

It has everything you need – from furniture and car accessories to artificial flowers and

soft toys for the kids.

So if you plan on spending a few hours here to shop, think again as even one day is not

enough to browse through the lot.

The Nilai 3 concept is similar to the factory outlets of branded goods, which are found in

Britain and the United States.

Tucked away from Seremban, this gigantic centre has up to 400 shops, selling all and sundry, such as kitchen utensils, textiles,

paintings and the like.

"The main attraction to me is the textiles.

There are so many different kinds to choose from and they are all affordable," said Suraya Ismail, 25, who have just bought six pieces of fabrics to make clothes for the upcoming Raya celebration. She added that she'd be coming

back to buy more later.

"I know it's a little too early to do my shopping, but this place will get very packed by the time the Raya month arrives and I'm not going to go through all the crowd, especially

on weekends," she said.

Textiles are a big hit among the ladies as the exotic cloths come from various countries like Indonesia, Myanmar, Thailand, China, Pakistan and India.

"The best thing about some of the shops here is that you can bargain your way, including my shop," said a bubbly supervisor for Al-Baz Textile, Linda Wati.

Linda said that her cheapest Thailand silk cost between RM30 and RM70 and they come in various colours, including pastel.

Her shop also offers the traditional

Malaysian baju kurung, headscarves, shawls
kain songket as well as the brooches and
songkok.

Just a few doors away from Al-Baz Textile, there is a shop which occupies about two lots, and it offers wedding accessories and artificial flowers.

It also sells souvenir paper bags, bunga telur, photo album, trays and all kinds of dainty stuff and gift items.

One interesting thing to note is that this shop not only sells various designs of souverir accessories taken in from China, Borneo, Indonesia, Thailand and Myanmar, it also sells custom-made accessories.

"We have even designed gifts and souvenirs for actor and television personality Jalaluddin Hassan and singer Bob Azrai's wedding," said

Syafinaz Ariffin, who is the supervisor of the shop, VR Star Sdn Bhd. Syafinaz added that they also design hantarans and do flower arrangements for free.

Additionally, they even design their own photo albums, which currently come in two different shades – gold and green.

"The photo albums cost between RM51 and RM68, with 100 pages. What sets them apart from other albums is the materials used in making them," said Syafinaz, who is the official designer for the company.

"We even deliver the items bought by our customers but, of course, we charge them a delivery fee. At least, in this way, they do not have to make another trip to collect the items," she said.

If you walk to the heart of Nilai 3, you would notice a huge roof hovering over about a hundred shops selling different kinds of goods.

One such shop is Idaman Collection Enterprise which sells a wide range of bags, be it working or casual bags.

The prices range from as low as RM1 to RM50 and they come in different shapes and colours to suit various tastes.

Manager of Idaman Collection Enterprise, Noorashidah Samat, said that the bags are brought in from Hong Kong, China, Taiwan, Myanmar and Thailand. She added that if you buy three bags, you are entitled to a free purse, provided the total on your receipt is at least RM100.

"Spider-man! Spongebob Squarepants! I want those, please!" cried four-year-old Mohd Fakri Syareeza, clinging on to his brother and sister.


